

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSION
MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING
APRIL 29, 1981

The Board of County Commission met this day in special session with the following members present, to-wit: Clayton Shiver, Chairman, Bobby Varnum, Donnell Whitfield, Jack Bowman and Monroe Cox.

Willie D. Wise, Clerk, was present and acting.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Shiver followed with prayer by Commissioner Varnum.

The purpose of the meeting was to review the budget and to discuss the county inventory.

A motion was made by Commissioner Whitfield, seconded by Commissioner Varnum and duly carried to rent the two houses at the County Road Yard for \$100.00 per month with \$125.00 deposit.

Mr. Mike Maloy was present for the meeting.

Mr. James Rowe with Gulf Asphalt met with the Board on the Altha road. After some discussion, Mr. Rowe agreed to put an additional 1/2-inch asphalt on the road.

Mr. Jim Doyle and Mike Tucker, Certified Public Accountants, met with the Board on the county audit.

Mr. Don Kline, CETA Director, met with the Board concerning the CETA Program.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bowman, seconded by Commissioner Whitfield and duly carried to disapprove Resolution #81-5 concerning the Apalachicola River Committee.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bowman, seconded by Commissioner Varnum and duly carried to adopt new personnel regulations as of May 1, 1981.

Commissioner Cox stated that he would like to go on record as opposing the road and bridge superintendent doing the hiring and firing as was the Board's policy now. Also, that the Board agreed on who was to be hired, but the road superintendent has power to fire any employee.


