

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSION
MINUTES OF SPECIAL SESSION
JUNE 1, 1981

The Board of County Commission met this day in special session with the following members present, to-wit: Clayton Shiver, Chairman, Bobby Varnum, Donnell Whitfield, Jack Bowman and Monroe Cox.

Willie D. Wise, Clerk, was present and acting..

Chairman Shiver stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the HUD Grant application. After some discussion, Commissioner Bowman recommended that the Board be polled to get an opinion on the HUD application.

A motion was made by Commissioner Whitfield, seconded by Commissioner Varnum and duly carried to accept the final HUD application as it is.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bowman, seconded by Commissioner Cox and duly carried for the Board to donate the lights at the S. B. Atkins Park for a ball tournament with the proceeds going to Mitch Chambers whose home was destroyed by fire.


Mr. Pack Bowden, Assistant Fire Chief of Altha, asked the Board for assistance in getting a tanker for fighting fire in the County.

Mr. Tommy Edwards, President of the Calhoun County Chamber of Commerce, presented the Board with a Resolution supporting the HUD Grant application. A motion was made by Commissioner Bowman, seconded by Commissioner Whitfield and duly carried to accept the Resolution from the Chamber.
