MINUTES OF SPECIAL SESSION
JULY 13, 1981

A special meeting of the Board of County Commission was called for the purpose of a budget review. Present and acting were Commissioners Varnum, Whitfield, Cox and Bowman. Clerk Willie D. Wise was present and acting. Chairman Shiver was absent due to being in the hospital.

Vice-chairman Varnum called the meeting to order.

Robert Nations with Florida Engineering met with the Board on the Wrennie Moody Road. Mr. Nations discussed cross-sectioning of the road.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bowman, seconded by Commissioner Whitfield and duly carried to have Florida Engineering do the cross-sectioning on Wrennie Moody Road if the charge for the service was less than \$2,000.00 and if it would be paid for from HUD funds.

Alvin Roberts spoke to the Board regarding filling the position at the Canning Center. The Board agreed to fill the position with CETA help, and if unable to get CETA help, the Board agreed to use the money that was brought in by the Canning Center to hire someone to run it until the money gives out.

Bill Corbin, County Attorney, presented the Board with an ordinance on garbage pickup. Ordinance No. 81-02 on garbage pickup was read and approved.
