


A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Richards and duly carried to adjourn. Meeting was adjourned.

MINUTES OF MEETING

APRIL 2, 1985

The Board of County Commissioners met this day in regular session, with the following members present to wit: Chairman Emmanuel Hires, Commissioners Charles Richards, Drew Peacock, Roy Bailey, and Ronald Wood.

Clerk Willie D. Wise, Sheriff W. G. Smith, County Attorney David House were present and acting.

The meeting was called to order by the Sheriff, followed with a prayer by Commissioner Wood and pledge allegiance to the flag.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Peacock, and duly carried to approve the minutes of the March 19, 1985 meeting, as read.

Mr. Mark Gardner, a representative of Time Energy Corp. made a report to the Board on the problems with the equipment for heating and cooling of county buildings.

Chairman Hires read a letter from Terry Madigan, an attorney who is representing Calhoun County on a HRS Suit, regarding mental health patients billings.

Chairman Hires also read a letter from Radcliff Materials, Inc., requesting a resolution supporting a renewal of their dredging permits.

Mr. Mitchell Pitts met with the Board requesting the closing of a road going through his property. The Board agreed to bring this before the body at the next meeting.

Chairman Hires read a letter from the Planning Commission regarding an unrecorded plat on the Apalachicola River.

Mr. Lorene Brown mad a report on the HUD Program.
