

## BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

## MINUTES OF MEETING

JUNE 18, 1985

The Board of County Commissioners met this date in regular session with the following members present to, wit: Chairman Emmanuel Hires , Commissioners Ronald Wood, Drew Peacock, Charles Richards, and Roy Bailey.

Deputy Clerk Carolann Bracewell, Attorney David House and Sheriff Buddy Smith were present and acting.

The meeting was called to order by Sheriff Smith, followed with prayer by Commissioner Ronald Wood, and pledge of allegiance to the flag.

The minutes of June 4, 1985 were read.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wood, seconded by Commissioner Peacock, and duly carried to accept the minutes of June 4, 1985 as read.

Chairman Hires read several letters received by the Board. He also presented a letter from George Gaskin, (son of the late Tot Gaskin). He is trying to sell his mothers property which is behind the Courthouse. He has it listed with the realtors for \$75,000.00 but would like to sell it to the County for \$70,000.00. The County Commissioners said that they would like to have the property but there were no funds available at this time.

Colonial Elofson's wife made a presentation on the Dam Removal Bill that was passed a year ago. She brought the Board up to date on the slow progression of the Bill. She explained the bureaucratic procedures that are taking place.

Mr. Joseph Hunt with the Apalachee Regional Planning Council, made a presentation concerning the County Hazardous Waste Management/Assessment Project. He explained the program in detail and asked the Board if they would like to fund the project or would they like the ARPC to fund it. The Board told Mr. Hunt, due to lack of funds, they would like the ARPC to fund the program. Mr. Hunt will draw up a proposed contract in the next few days and give to the County Attorney.
