


The Board of County Commissioners met in special session for the purpose of declaring Calhoun County in a state of emergency for Hurricane Kate, a category 3 storm.



It was the unanimous concurrence of the Board of County Commissioners to declare Calhoun County in the state of emergency and gave the Civil Defense Director the authority to carry out disaster procedures for Calhoun County and co-ordinate with adjoining counties.


