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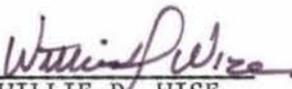

OFFICE SPACE

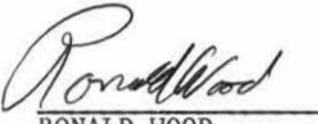
ADDITIONAL OFFICE SPACE FOR THE CLERKS OFFICE
