DATE.

COMMISSIONER WOOD CALLED THE MEETING TOGETHER
FOR THE PURPOSE OF A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE
PROPOSED FISCAL YEAR 87-88 BUDGET.

2-A MENTAL HEALTH
COUNCIL SPACE IN COURTHOUSE
DISCUSSED

CLERK WISE STATED THERE HAD BEEN AN INCIDENT
IN THE COURTHOUSE TODAY BY A CLIENT OF THE 2-A
MENTAL HEALTH COUNCIL, CONSISTING OF A CLIENT
EXPOSING HIMSELF TO A SIX YEAR OLD CHILD. HE
STATED LAST MONTH ONE OF THE PATIENTS HAD
THREATENED BODILY HARM TO TWO COURT HOUSE
EMPLOYEES.

MOTION TO HAVE
2-A MENTAL HEALTH
VACATE THEIR OFFICES

AFTER DISCUSSION, THE MOTION BY COMMISSIONER
RICHARDS, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HIRES AND
DULY CARRIED TO ISSUE A THIRTY DAY NOTICE TO
THE 2-A DISTRICT MENTAL HEALTH COUNCIL TO
VACATE THEIR OFFICES ON THE THIRD FLOOR.

APPROXIMATELY SEVEN PERSONS WERE PRESENT FOR
THE PUBLIC HEARING.

MILAGE CAP EXPLAINED

COMMISSIONER WOOD EXPLAINED TO THE AUDIENCE
THAT THE BOARD HAS FOR THE PAST TWO YEARS BEEN
AT 10 MILS AND THEY COULD NOT RAISE TAXES DUE
TO A 10 MIL CAP.

DISSATISFACTION VOICED
INRE TAX INCREASE

SEVERAL PERSONS VOICED THEIR DISSATISFACTION
WITH THE INCREASED TAX ASSESSMENT ON THEIR
PROPERTY. THE BOARD EXPLAINED THAT FRANK
STONE, PROPERTY APPRAISER HAD EXPLAINED TO
THEM THAT D.O.R. HAD RAISED THE SQUARE
FOOTAGE RATE FROM \$17.50 TO \$21.50 PER SQUARE

MOTION TO STOP SPENDING
UNTIL END OF FISCAL YEAR

COMMISSIONER HIRES MOVED TO PUT A STOP TO ANY SPENDING WHETHER TO BE IMPROVEMENT, NEW CONSTRUCTION, OR UPDATING, THAT IS NOT IN THE NORMAL COURSE OF OPERATION FOR THE REST OF THIS FISCAL YEAR AND TO RUN THE COURSE OF THIS ACTION UNTIL BUDGET FINALIZATION FOR 1987-1988. SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER RICHARDS AND DULY CARRIED.

BUDGET REVIEWED

CLERK WISE AND THE BOARD WENT THROUGH THE PROPOSED 87-88 BUDGET BY FUND.

BUDGET TENTATIVELY
APPROVED

AFTER MUCH DISCUSSION, A MOTION BY BY COMMISSIONER RICHARDS, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HIRES AND DULY CARRIED TO TENTATIVELY APPROVE THE 1987-1988 BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,878,493.00 WITH A MILAGE RATE OF 10 MILS.
