THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY SHERIFF
SMITH AND FOLLOWED WITH PRAYER BY COMMISSIONER
HIRES AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG.

DR. SNYDER IN RE: PRIMARY
HEALTH CARE, ADDITIONAL
SPACE OR NEW BUILDING
AND ASKING ASSISTANCE IN
ASKING LEGISLATURE TO
APPROPRIATE \$450,000.00
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION
OF A NEW PUBLIC HEALTH
UNIT AND ADVISED THE BCC
THAT THE STATE IS FUNDING
\$65,000.00 FOR EQUIPMENT

DR GRAYSON SNYDER, CALHOUN COUNTY HEALTH
DEPARTMENT WAS PRESENT AT THE MEETING TO
ADDRESS PRIMARY HEALTH CARE FOR POVERTY LEVEL
INCOME FAMILIES. DR. SNYDER REPORTED 23 1/2%
OF THE RESIDENTS OF CALHOUN COUNTY ARE POVERTY
LEVEL AND WOULD FALL UNDER THE GUIDELINES FOR
PRIMARY HEALTH CARE. HE STATED IN ORDER TO
PROVIDE THIS SERVICE, THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT
NEEDED MORE SPACE OR NEW BUILDING AND ASKED
FOR THE BOARDS ASSISTANCE IN ASKING THE
LEGISLATURE TO APPROPRIATE \$450,000.00 FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW PUBLIC HEALTH UNIT IN
CALHOUN COUNTY. DR. SNYDER ADVISED THE STATE
IS FUNDING \$65,000.00 FOR EQUIPMENT. DR.
SNYDER ALSO REPORTED WITH PRIMARY HEALTH CARE,
THE BASIC NEEDS OF INDIGENTS COULD BE MET
WITHOUT CREATING A BURDEN ON THE LOCAL
HOSPITAL.

MOTION TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION

AFTER DISCUSSION COMMISSIONER HIRES STATED IN
LIGHT OF INFORMATION RECEIVED THIS EVENING,
THIS WOULD NOT BE A LIABILITY FOR THE COUNTY,
BUT WOULD BE A PLUS HEALTH WISE AND
ECONOMICALLY AND THEREFORE MOVED TO ENDORSE,
SUPPORT AND ADOPT A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE
STATE LEGISLATURE TO APPROPRIATE \$450,000.00
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PUBLIC HEALTH UNIT
IN CALHOUN COUNTY CONTINGENT UPON THE
ENDORSEMENT OF CALHOUN GENERAL HOSPITAL AND
THE DOCTORS OF THE COMMUNITY'S APPROVAL.
SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER RICHARDS AND CARRIED
