THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY COMMISSIONER WHITFIELD AND FOLLOWED WITH PRAYER BY COMM. DILLARD AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG.

APPROXIMATELY 30 CITIZENS ATTENDED THE PUBLIC HEARING.

Clerk Wise presented and read aloud the proposed Revenues and Expenditures, by line item, of the Proposed Operating Budget for Calhoun County for 1990-91. He reported the total proposed Operating Budget, all funds combined for 1990-91 is \$3,294,015.

The audience posed many questions re: 6¢ gas tax, proposed 10% franchise fee and State Mandates.

After much discussion, Motion by Commissioner Dillard to tentatively adopt the 1990-1991 Proposed Budget in the amount of \$3,294,015 and to tentatively adopt the Millage Rate of 10 Mills.
