The meeting was called to order immediately after the vote of the Planning Council to transfer the Comprehensive Plan to the Board of County Commissioners.


The meeting was called to order by Chairman Whitfield.

Mr. Andy Easton of Clark, Roumelis stated that the Board could transfer the plan tonight and DCA would have 105 days to approve the plan. At the end of the 105 days an organizational, recommendation, Comments, (ORC) report. At that time the County has 60 days to approve the plan. You must submit the plan within 90 days of March 1, 1992 to DCA. The County must publish two weeks consecutively, a notice of transmittal. the notice is to be published the 9th and 16th with a public hearing on the 23rd of May.

Commissioner Melvin made a motion to advertise for two weeks and hold a public hearing on the 23rd of May, 2nd by Commissioner Bowden and carried 4-0.
