THE PUBLIC HEARING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY CHAIRMAN BOWDEN AT 5:15 P.M.

MS. MARSHA HARPOOL REPRESENTING THE APALACHEE REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL (FAPC) ADDRESSED THE BOARD EXPLAINING THAT 119 JOBS HAD BEEN CREATED BY THE FLORIDA AQUACULTURE PROCESSING CO-OP (FAPC) INSTEAD OF THE 112 LOW-MODERATE INCOME (LMI) JOBS, 83 HAD BEEN DOCUMENTED TO DCA'S APPROVAL.

COMMISSIONER WHITFIELD MADE THE MOTION TO AMEND THE GRANT AGREEMENT TO 83 LMI JOBS CREATED AND CLOSE OUT THE GRANT WITH DCA, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER GRANT. MOTION CARRIED 5-0.


MR. FRANK GATES REPRESENTING FAPC REPORTED THAT \$300,000 OF THE FMHA LOAN HAD BEEN DRAWN DOWN. CURRENTLY THERE IS A LAYOFF AT THE PLANT DUE TO THE LACK OF MARKET FOR THE FISH AT THIS PRESENT TIME. APPROXIMATELY 20 PEOPLE ARE CURRENTLY WORKING AT THE PLANT FOUR DAY WEEKS, TEN HOURS A DAY.
