COMMISSIONER WHITFIELD CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AND STATED, BASED UPON ADVICE FROM MATT FUQUA, COUNTY ATTORNEY, HE COULD NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE RANKING OR SELECTION OF APPLICANTS, DUE TO HIS FIRST COUSIN BEING AN APPLICANT. HE ADVISED COMMISSIONER ATTAWAY HAD RECEIVED THE SAME ADVICE AS COMMISSIONER ATTAWAY'S BROTHER WAS AN APPLICANT.

COMMISSIONER WHITFIELD RELINQUISHED THE CHAIR TO COMMISSIONER GRANT AND LEFT THE MEETING.

THE BOARD BY CONSENSUS DECIDED THAT EACH COMMISSIONER PRESENT WOULD RECOMMEND 3 CANDIDATES AND PRESENT THEIR NAMES AT A SPECIAL MEETING.

THE BOARD DECIDED TO INSTRUCT THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO RESEARCH THE COUNTY'S RECRUITMENT POLICY AND UNION CONTRACT AND TO REPORT BACK TO THE BOARD AT THE SPECIAL MEETING.

AFTER DISCUSSION, THE BOARD SCHEDULED A SPECIAL BOARD MEETING FOR TUESDAY, MARCH 28, 2000 AT 6:00 P.M. TO RECEIVE COMMISSIONERS 3 RECOMMENDATIONS.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, THE BOARD DID ADJOURN.
