The Public Hearing was called to order by Deputy Vickery, prayer by Chairman Whitfield and pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Mr. Tony Arrant, Planning Commission Consultant recommended the Board of County Commissioners adopt Ordinance 2000-01 amending, revising and replacing in its entirety the Comprehensive Plan of Calhoun County, Florida, which will control future land use, guide public facilities, and protect natural resources pursuant to the Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land Development Regulation Act (Chapter 163, Part II Florida Statutes), including a Future Land Use Element; Traffic Circulation Element; Housing Element; Infrastructure Element; Conservation Element; Recreation Element; Intergovernmental Coordination Element; and Capital Improvements Element; providing for severability, and providing for an effective date, including revisions to address the DCA objections, recommendation and comments report.


Mr. Arrant also recommended the Board of County Commissioners adopt the 2000-2010 Future Land Use Map.
