

## **Request for Qualifications Airport General Consulting Services at Calhoun County Airport (2022-017)**

In accordance with Florida Statutes and FAA Advisory Circular 150/5100-14E, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) of Calhoun County, Florida invites the submission of Statements of Qualifications from all interested and qualified parties with demonstrated expertise in **Airport General Consulting Services** for the Calhoun County Airport. Projects may include but are not limited to the planning and/or design of the following: airfield pavement improvements and rehabilitation, airfield lighting improvements, aircraft hangars, utility systems, airport master plans, surveying, airspace studies, stormwater design and permitting, utility infrastructure, building improvements, fences, fuel storage facilities, and airport industrial parks.

Submittals must be received no later than **1:00 p.m. Central (local time) on Tuesday September 6, 2022**. Submittals shall be sealed and clearly marked on the outside "**Airport General Consulting Services at Calhoun County Airport 2022-017.**" Statements received after the closing time will be returned unopened.
